

Learning Agreements

Learning agreement (LA)is by some of the incoming exchange students including by **ERASMUS**, EUCORE, DAAD, Freemover students

The LA is a contract between you, your home university and host university regarding your studies

- LA must always be signed by all 3 parties:
 - by you (student)
 - the subject coordinator (FK) of your home university and
 - the subject coordinator (FK) at the partner university (KIT departmental coordinator)

It is important to comply with your LA.

Please upload and update your LA in Mobility Online Processing time is around 14 days





Learning Agreements

- When completing your LA include:
 - Name of the module in English and when applicable also in German too
 - Modulnummer / Module number and the Teilleistungen / Number
 - Please ensure that you enroll at least 70-80% Informatic Modules/course(s)
- Please ensure that you enroll and complete at least the minimum of required ECTS required by your home university.
- Processing your LA may take up to 14 days
- Changes to the LA "during the mobility"
 - You may adjust your LA during your time at KIT
 - due to time conflicts or other study interests
 - · Consult and seek approval from your home university when updating your LA
 - Update it in Mobility Online
 - For any changes please make them by <u>25 November 2025</u>
